

TOP 10 REASONS TO LOCATE YOUR RETAIL BUSINESS ON SOLANO AVENUE

- 1. Solano Avenue runs east/west near the north end of Berkeley, and on into Albany. It is a charming, tree-lined boulevard with a mile of great shopping, dining and professional services, and with convenient street parking.
- 2. Solano Avenue's over 500 businesses include 75 restaurants, 150 retail shops, two movie theaters and pocket parks.
- 3. Good lighting and safe neighborhoods make it delightful for window-shopping after dinner or the movies.
- 4. Solano Avenue is a thriving neighborhood shopping street. Every year on the second Sunday of September, businesses along Solano Avenue host a street festival called the Solano Stroll, which attracts hundreds of thousands of attendees.
- 5. Over 277,000 residents live within five miles, with an average annual household income of over \$93,000. The daytime population within five minutes is 64,613.
- 6. The area is populated by highly educated residents. 73% of residents within 1 mile have a bachelor's degree or more. In a 5 mile radius, 52% of residents have a bachelor's degree or more.
- 7. Solano Avenue is just 1.5 miles from downtown Berkeley and from the University of California at Berkeley. Cal has a daily population of approximately 50,000 people.
- 8. Solano Avenue is about a 15-20 minute walk to both the El Cerrito Plaza and North Berkeley BART stations. It is well served by AC Transit buses that run the length of the street.
- 9. Join national and regional tenants already on Solano Avenue including: Zachary's Pizza, Cactus Taqueria, A.G. Ferrari, Peet's Coffee & Tea, Andronico's Market, Starbucks Coffee, and Pharmaca.
- 10. Join local retailers including Shoes on Solano, Ideas 4 Elements, Bone Room, Sue Johnson Custom Lamps & Shades, Pugnacious Pug and Yoga for Life.
